## CANCELLATION POLICY

A full tuition refund will be made to any student who cancels the enrollment contract within 48 hours (until midnight of the second day excluding Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays) after the enrollment contract is signed provided that students has not attend any class yet. Equipment cost is refund minus \$100 restocking fee if the order has been placed.

## REFUND POLICY

1. Refund is available for students who complete no more than half (6 hours) of the course and is dissatisfied with the course; and who requests in writing, providing a reasonable basis for their dissatisfaction, no later than the 14<sup>th</sup> day after the date the course is concluded.
2. Computations will be based on scheduled course time of class attendance through the last date of attendance. Leaves of absence, suspensions and school holidays will not be counted as part of the scheduled class attendance.
3. If tuition and fees are collected in advance of entrance, and if after expiration of the 48 hour cancellation privilege the student does not enter school, not more than \$100 in any administrative fees charged shall be retained by the school for the entire courses.
4. If a student enters the program and withdraws or is otherwise terminated after the cancellation period, the school or college may retain not more than \$100 in any administrative fees charged for the entire program. The minimum refund of the remaining tuition and fees will be the pro rata portion of tuition, fees, and other charges that the number of hours remaining in the portion of the course or program for which the student has been charged after the effective date of termination bears to the total number of hours in the portion of the course or program for which the student has been charged, except that a student may not collect a refund if the student has completed 50 percent or more of the total number of hours in the portion of the program for which the student has been charged on the effective date of termination.
5. Refunds for equipment purchase are to be handled separately from refund of tuition. If student has not taking delivery of equipment, full refund is allowed minus \$100 restocking fee. Once student take delivery of the equipment, no refund will be made.
6. A full refund of all tuition and fees is due and refundable in each of the following cases:
  - (a) An enrollee is not accepted by the school;

- (b) If the course of instruction is discontinued by the school and this prevents the student from completing the course; or
- (c) If the student's enrollment was procured as a result of any misrepresentation in advertising, promotional materials of the school, or representations by the owner or representatives of the school.
